
CONVERSATION CENTRAL...

WHERE IN AFRICA...

Did you know there are 54 countries on the continent of Africa? We are learning about Nigeria, and it is the country in Africa that has the most people in it.

Now its time to find out where the country of Nigeria is in Africa.

- 1. Nigeria is in West Africa, use the compass to help you find the western side of Africa and draw an arrow to it.
- 2. Nigeria shares land borders with the Republic of Benin to the west, find Benin and color it RED.
- 3. Chad and Cameroon are to the east, color them YELLOW.
- 4. Niger is to the north of Nigeria, color it BLUE.
- 5. Now Label and color Nigeria GREEN.

Now you know some of the countries that are on the African continent.




KALEIDOSCOPE PAGE




Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

KIDS KALEIDOSCOPE ACTIVITIES

Head Carrying Game





This is a game that can be adapted to the materials you have around you, and it also develops balance, a very important skill.

Supplies: A long scarf, a wide, unbreakable bowl or basket, and items to carry

Directions: Roll the scarf into a nest-like circle that fits on top of the child's head. Let him or her practice walking around while balancing the scarf on their head. Then, set the bowl or basket on top of the scarf and see if they can carry it across the room. Then, add various items to the bowl or basket and see what they can carry.

This game can be done in teams or individually. You can also add as many different items to the baskets as you want; be creative and have fun.
